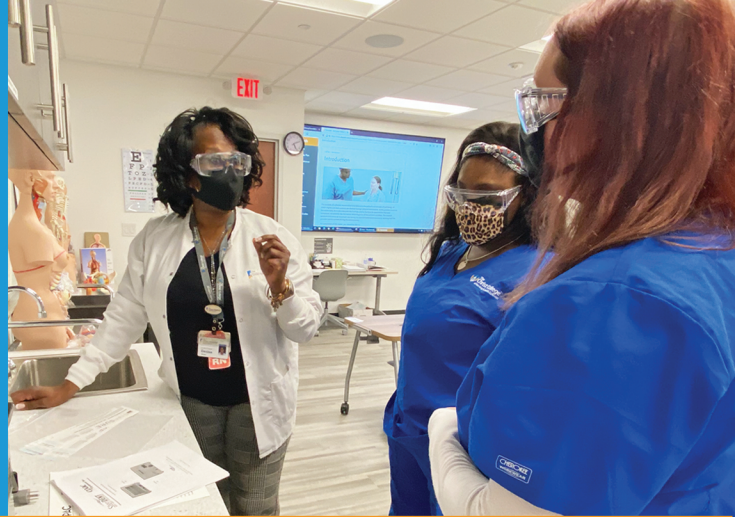

2. Submit high school transcript, GED, or all previously attended college or university transcripts.
 - Must be official and in a sealed envelope or emailed from originating institution
 - No copies or faxed transcripts
 - High school seniors must submit their current official transcript at the time of application and a final transcript after graduation.
