

## Chatfield College and The Christ College of Nursing and Health Sciences Articulated Pathway to Medical Assisting Clinical Certificate

1. Chatfield College students will apply for admission to The Christ College of Nursing and Health Sciences' Medical Assisting Clinical Certificate program (MACC) after their first semester at Chatfield College. The MACC program enrolls each semester (Fall, Spring, and Summer).

After completing the MACC courses, students can reverse transfer the credits to Chatfield College to complete the Medical Assisting Pathway portion of their A.A. in Liberal Arts program. Note: All MA courses, BIO 160, and BIO 102 will be taught by and at TCCNHS.

### Years 1 and 2 at Chatfield College

Courses required by the Chatfield College's Liberal Arts with Medical Assisting Pathway program would include the following core requirements and the Medical Assisting Pathway courses. Please discuss your course schedule with your Academic Advisor at Chatfield College to plan your first two years and work towards degree completion at Chatfield College. The Medical Assisting pathway can be completed after a student's first semester at Chatfield College.

#### A.A. in Liberal Arts with Medical Assisting Pathway Curriculum Overview

Chatfield College's Associate of Liberal Arts degree is based on 60 semester credit hours. There are 39 credits from the Core and 21 credits from electives. The Medical Assisting Pathway will consist of 16 hours of required courses taken at TCCNHS, and two elective courses which can be taken at either Chatfield College or The Christ College of Nursing and Health Sciences.
