



Proof of CPR Certification:

RN-BSN students are expected to maintain

RN-BSN students are required to submit proof of CPR/BLS certification via Blackboard (class assignment) at the beginning of each clinical practicum course – NUR 435 and NUR 450.

The Christ College of Nursing and Health Sciences **does not** accept CPR certification from **online** courses and requires certification from the **American Heart Association**. Students who do not comply will not be allowed to continue enrollment at The Christ College of Nursing and Health Sciences.

IMPORTANT: Check your card expiration date and make sure you are certified through the American Heart Association **before** submitting proof. Need recertification? Register for a class in one of two ways.
